**Equipment** - We will be using PC<sup>2</sup>. You may use only 1 computer during the contest. You may use only one keyboard, one monitor, and one mouse.

**Teams / Divisions** – Big School ( 4A / 5A ) and Small School ( 1A / 2A / 3A ) will be in separate divisions. Beginner and advanced teams will be separated as well if enough teams enter the contest. It is up to each coach to ensure that teams are in the correct division.

**Written Test** - The written test will only test Java. We will use the 6 & 2 UIL scoring. The test will be UIL format and will only test UIL topics. You may not use calculators on the written test.

**Programming Languages** - You may program using only JAVA.

**Format** - The contest will consist of a 2 hour programming contest and 45 minute written test. There will be 12 programming problems that reflect concepts normally tested on UIL programming problems. All problems will require that you read all input from DATA FILES!!!!
